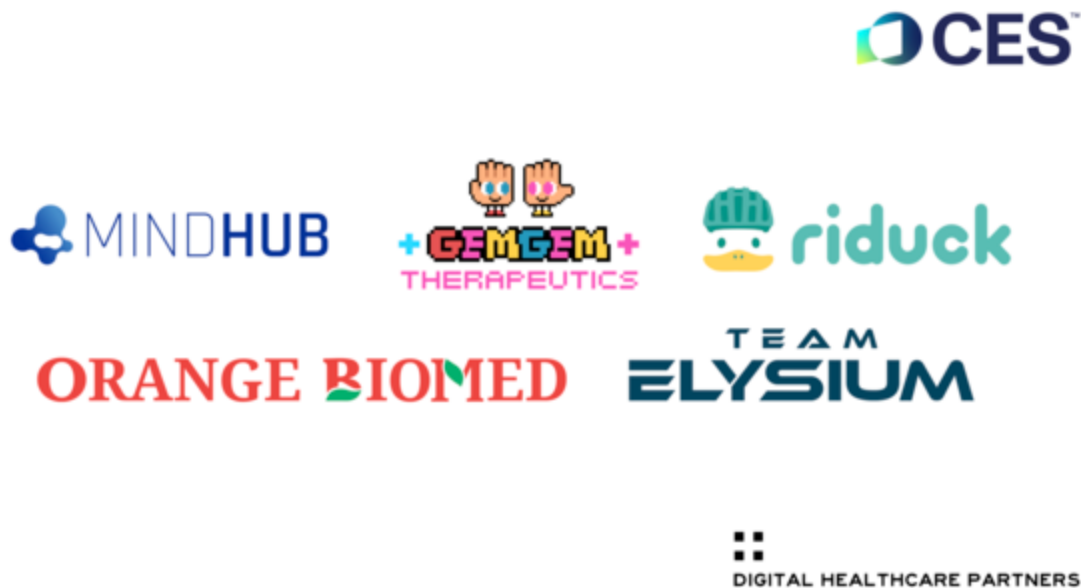


Five DHP Investment Startups to Participate in CES 2025

Five portfolio startups invested by Digital Healthcare Partners (DHP) will participate in the world's largest information technology (IT) and home appliance exhibition, 'CES 2025'. The number of Korean companies participating in CES 2025, which will be held in Las Vegas, USA from the 7th to the 10th, is the largest ever.

DHP investment startups participating in CES 2025 are ▲ MindHub (computerized cognitive rehabilitation solution) ▲ JamJam Therapeutics (AR-based pediatric upper limb rehabilitation solution) ▲ Lyduc (cycling and aerobic coaching app) ▲ Orange Biomed (portable glyced

hemoglobin measuring device) ▲ Team Elysium (3D sensor-based body measurement). In particular, Team Elysium's 'BodyDot Fitness' won the Innovation Award in the fitness category for its next-generation AI body shape analyzer using a 3D sensor.

They plan to network with local experts and industry insiders at CES and explore opportunities to enter global markets.

DHP CEO Yoon-Seop Choi said, "DHP portfolios are making full-fledged inroads into global markets, including North America," and added, "We plan to continue to actively invest in digital healthcare startups with the potential to advance into the global market."

DHP is Korea's only digital healthcare startup investment firm established in 2016. As of now, DHP has invested in a total of 47 digital healthcare startups.
